These improvement projects would never have been completed without the support and dedication from my fellow board members and you, the members. Thank you.

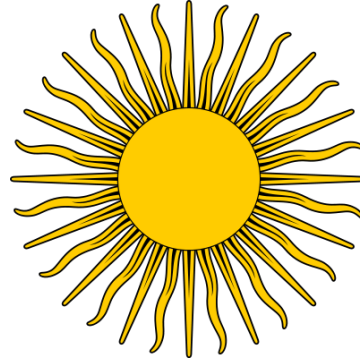
The friendships and strong community at the club is why I return every week and will continue to support the club in any way I can in the years to follow.

## Savings drop after April expenses

One-time expenses took a bite out of the German-American Club budget in April, including \$8,541 for repairs and maintenance and \$4,000 for building and liquor insurance policies.

Part of it was for striping and repaving the parking lot, a down payment for the roof repair and rehabilitation of the walk-in cooler, treasurer Ingrid Stewart explained in her monthly report at the May 20 membership meeting.

Operating savings dropped from \$15,000 to \$10,000, but the club still has about \$68,000 in reserves, she assured members.

Despite the bills and costs, the club turned a \$200 profit during the month.

The building is aged, built in the 1970s, and one thing led to another during some of the repairs, said Christina Gibson. She thanked several members for their hard work on the roof and cooler.

"It's pretty iron-clad tight and good to go for a while," she said about club facilities.

We're taking \$1,000 from the roof contingency fund to fix the duct work and flashing for the air conditioner, which was incorrectly mounted when it was installed five years ago. A high portion of cold air was escaping the system, so the club's going to be much cooler this summer when the work is completed, vice president Gary Blanton promised.

In other news from the meeting, membership chairwoman Beverly Long reiterated that annual fees are due by July 1, and if you pay early you'll get a free drink ticket in the mail with your membership card. She collected \$800 in dues at the May 19 Maifest.

President Leanne Krinker set an Oktoberfest meeting for 6:30 p.m. June 15 to finalize plans for the annual celebration that brings in the most revenue for the club for a single event. We're not having it at the Fifth Street School in downtown Las Vegas this year due to the event being cancelled by the city.

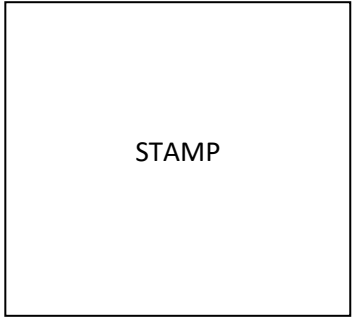
