Get your tee times



Valentine's Cabaret



The German-American Club was treated to a special appearance by jazz guitarist Calvin Brooks, sitting in for Bobby Howard during the Tuesday night jazz jams in February.

This Detroit lefty played a regular gig for years at Harrah's on the Strip, and was featured at the City of Las Vegas Reed Whipple Cultural Center concert series. We've also seen him at E String in Henderson, Rancho Wildfire, Sand Dollar Blues Lounge and various other hip joints around Las Vegas.

Brooks can take a crowd from his Motown roots with rhythm and blues and a soulful rendition of something by the Temptations to wooing you with his smooth voice and scintillating guitar on jazz standards like "Autumn Leaves."

He's one of five children, the son of a Detroit autoworker and homemaker who recognized his musical talent and sent him to the Grinnell School of Music. You'll hear his guitar influences from Wes Montgomery, Grant Green and George Benson.

Melody Louise began playing and singing professionally at age 13. By age 15 she was traveling the U.S. playing Hiltons, Sheratons and other resorts. At 19, performing under the name "Melody Lane", she was fronting her own band in Las Vegas, having the distinction of being the youngest entertainer on the Strip at that time. Venues included the Tropicana, Sands, Flamingo, MGM, Bally's, Luxor, Hilton and Frontier among several others.

She starred as Patsy Cline in the well-known "Legends in Concert" show at the Imperial Palace and opened for the Four Freshmen at the Showboat. She has received high acclaim for her versatile vocal styling and delivery. Her poised demeanor and earthy voice cradles the audience as she sings songs from Patsy Cline, Carol King, Adele to Pat Benatar. Melody will also dazzle you as she plays Guitar.



Theodore Kolb studied Music Theory at Tacoma Community College and Jazz Piano at Pacific Lutheran University in Tacoma, WA.
