700 years of brewing history



Roof repair approved for \$15,000

Before we get flooded with deferred maintenance costs, the German-American Club unanimously approved up to \$15,000 to repair a leaky roof at the April 22 board meeting.

The club was built in the 1970s, and the roof has been leaking for about eight years, maintenance supervisor Jon Shogren said. He led a group of members that compared estimates before settling on a proposal by The Roof Doctor, a roofing contractor that's been doing business in Las Vegas since 1985.

The estimate for the "torch-down" roof method was for \$10,000, but Jon asked for an additional \$5,000 to rip out plywood, lift the air conditioning unit and use any extra money for insulation.

"This has been a battle," Jon said at the meeting. "We've done a lot of work for the last three years, but we're almost coming to the end on the major stuff. The only thing left is the roof."

Club member Mike O'Brien, former operations manager for shopping centers, hotels and other commercial properties, said he's supervised many roof repairs and this cost is cheaper than it was 20 years ago.

"I'm 79. It's going to outlast me," Mike said of the 10-year warranty.

The project is expected to be completed in May and will take about a week.

In other business, membership director Beverly Long said 61 members haven't paid their dues. "It's frustrating for me," she said. One member suggested posting a "Shame List" on the wall, and another had a more drastic approach: No drinks without a membership card.

Jon asked for volunteers to help paint the bar area, and after short discussion, members decided on May 9-10 so as not to disrupt club activities. The painting project starts at 10 a.m. each day, and pizza will be served courtesy of Gary and Mary.

Andy croons at annual Picnic


