Erika Gries: 1948-2020

Erika Gries, a German-American Club member since 1986 and queen of the potato pancakes, passed away in August at age 71. She was from Koblenz, Germany, and came to Las Vegas in 1974, most recently working as chef supervisor at Southern Nevada Health and Rehab.

Erika packed the club regularly on nights she cooked, then took her seat at the bar where she was often the ringleader for drinking games into the wee morning hours.

She served as club trustee and helped organize Octoberfest celebrations for 25 years. She met her late husband, Gene, at the club, and found the love of Mike Sipes for the final years of her life.

"She was my wife," Mike said. "The lunches I got to take to work every day ... she made coffee for me and packed my lunch before I got my teeth brushed."

Erika closely guarded her potato pancake recipe, moving around to block Mike's view when she was mixing a batch of ingredients, afraid he might sell or trade the recipe, or give it to someone else in the club.

"Erika was a driving force of the club," longtime member Art Ruckle said. "She did a lot. I've got great memories of her. I gave her away to Gene at their wedding."

A memorial will be held when the club reopens. Services at Boulder City Veterans Cemetery have yet to be scheduled.

Board handles quick business

The German-American Club completed its 2019 taxes and paid for insurance in August, creating a \$1,000 "hole" with no incoming revenue for the month, treasurer Ingrid Stewart reported at the Sept. 3 board meeting.

With a short agenda, the meeting lasted less than an hour. It was conducted via Zoom with president Gary Blanton, secretary Chris Januska, treasurer Ingrid Stewart and members-at-large Margie Klaus, Natalia Blanton and Joyce Drenckhahn online. Vice president Gene Hickman was present at the club.

Also attending the meeting were by-law committee members Art Ruckle, Steve Oldham and Ray Smith.

The by-law committee will meet twice a month to update the by-laws and make any necessary amendments, with the draft to be voted upon by members before ratification in May 2021.

Golf committee chairman Steve Oldham proposed a memorial golf tournament for early November as an avenue to raise money for the club. He set a target of \$1,000, possibly more. The tournament would be held at Durango Hills Golf Course in Las Vegas and would replace the club's annual tournament in Laughlin. Steve wasn't sure about holding an awards banquet, though it could be "touchless" and held at a private location.

In new business, Gene asked the board about possibly increasing our \$25,000 surety bond. After discussion between Steve and Chris over the difference between a surety bond and insurance, Gene was directed to talk to the broker for further clarification.
