As a child during World War II, Maxi remembers retreating to the basement of her home when the sirens sounded, signaling that her city was under siege. She left Germany, hoping for a better life in America, when she met and married her husband, Jake, who was stationed in France with the U.S. Air Force, in 1959. They lived in several states before coming to Las Vegas from Texas in 1971 and remained in the desert after Jake retired from military service. The German-American Club, in its first year of existence, attracted Maxi to a Maifest celebration at the convention center, and she joined as the club's 27th member. Most of the members were military. She recalls the club purchasing its current property, a fast-food restaurant that never opened, in 1981. "We worked our ass off when we bought this building," Maxi says. "We were open every day." You'll recognize Maxi at the club as the sassy lady not afraid to speak her mind.
