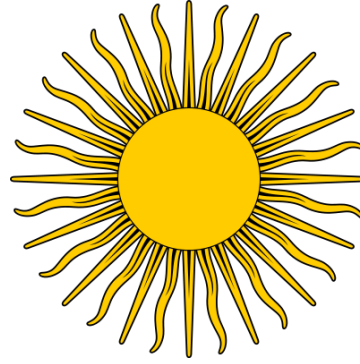


World Cup good sportsmanship

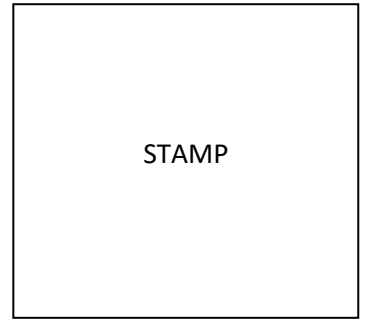
